JT Foster Awards, Graduation, and Valedictorian

For anybody who may be interested in understanding student enrollment and academic achievement **requirements for Valedictorian**, please see the following criteria from the JT Foster handbook:

The valedictorian shall be the student demonstrating the highest overall aggregate mark in English 30-1, Social Studies 30-1, and three (3) of the following taken at J. T. Foster School:

- Mathematics 30-1
- Physics 30
- Mathematics 30-2
- One 30-level CTS (min. five credits) or Green Certificate
- Mathematics 31 Certificate course
- Biology 30
- A language or Fine Art other than English at the 30 Level
- Chemistry 30

He has a wealth of information for supporting students with executive functioning (actions that people use to manage themselves toward their goals and the future). How might the techniques below support your child while studying or completing schoolwork at home?

Task Initiation

- Create checklists with very small steps when doing assignments. This is particularly important for classes/ tasks that your child is not interested in.
- For example: creating a pamphlet for social studies step 1) open the Chromebook; step 2) open Canva; step 3) find a cool template; step 4) ...
- These steps may seem obvious, but laying it out in this way can build momentum.

On Monday, we had a great presentation for our Junior High Students about consent and online safety and Pink Shirt Day on Wednesday. Sometimes, these events can spark conversations or reminders to have conversations with our children about their well-being and the relationships they are making. These conversations can often move into territories we aren't used to navigating and can bring up uncomfortable feelings for our children and for ourselves.
