What a week! Thank you to so many parents, guardians and children for the many kind emails. We are going to be starting online studies officially on Monday. I know our teachers have already begun to reach out to their students with instructions, and this email will serve as our starting point.

Check out <<u>Continuing Student Learning</u>> released today from the Ministry of Education. It provides information about Provincial Achievement Tests (PATs) Diploma Exams (DIPs) and graduation.

As we move forward, there will be missteps and kinks along the way. Please feel free to reach out to us at any time, and we will help in whatever way we can. Emails to <<u>s-jtfoster@lrsd.ab.ca</u>> are accessed by all of us in the office and will be responded to the most quickly.

This past week we called as many families as we



could; the vital information gathered will be used to make the new reality as seamless as possible. First of all, if you identified that you needed a device or have poor internet, we will be in contact early in the new week to provide alternatives. Our school division is preparing some Chromebooks to lend out if necessary. The hope is for this loan program to be available early next week.

In Junior High, education content will focus on core mathematics, language/literacy, science and social studies curriculum outcomes. Teachers will assign an average of 10 hours of work per student per week and will be expected to work with their students and parents on the delivery of these materials.

In Senior High, Grades 10-12 education content will focus on specified and core courses required for high school graduation requirements, including language, social studies, mathematics, biology, chemistry and physics. Content from other courses will be delivered where possible, and accommodations for students unable to complete courses are in place. Teachers will assign an average of 3 hours of work per course per week and will be expected to work with their students and parents on the delivery of these materials.
