### **BURSARIES**

We are offering two or more bursary awards (depending on funds available) of \$1,000.00 each. These awards are intended to assist in the advancement of education for the following students (in order of eligibility):

- 2. Grandchildren of Veterans who are members of the Nanton Branch of the Legion or Auxiliary who are attending school in this area (Nanton, Parkland, Cayley).
- 3. Grandchildren of Veterans who are members of the Nanton Branch of the Legion or Auxiliary who are attending school out of this area, in or out of Province.
- 4. Great-Grandchildren of Veterans who are members of the Nanton Branch of the Legion or Auxiliary who are attending school in this area. (Nanton, Parkland, Cayley).
- 5. Great-Grandchildren of Veterans who are members of the Nanton Branch of the Legion or Auxiliary who are attending school out of this area, in or out of Province.
- 6. Children, Grandchildren, or Great-Grandchildren of any member of the Legion or Auxiliary (Nanton Branch).
- 7. Children, Grandchildren, or Great-Grandchildren of Veterans.

- 1. The intention of these bursaries is that they be awarded to two or more students who are seriously interested in furthering their education in a way acceptable to this committee and can provide proof of acceptance at a furthering education facility outside the community. Should there be an insufficient number of applications; the money will be put aside for use in succeeding years.
- 2. Students applying for these Bursaries may apply in the year they graduate or they may wait and apply any succeeding year during the course of their studies at a University or a College.
- 3. The application form must be completed by the student desiring one of these Bursary awards. Basis of this award is proficiency in studies, personal qualities, evidence of a serious purpose and financial need.
- 4. Two letters of reference are required to be attached to the completed application forms (a) one from the student applying for the bursary outlining his/her reasons why the bursary money is needed as well as reasons for choosing the selected course and (b) 2 letters of recommendation from JT Foster Principal, Homeroom Teacher, or Student Counselor or for 2<sup>nd</sup> year & consequent years, a letter from the university/college that they are attending. A copy of your Grade 12 marks or marks from the university/college is also required to be attached to the completed application form.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained from your High School or from The Royal Canadian Legion Nanton Branch #80 (Terry Atkinson 646-5926) or member of the Bursary Committee, Ladies Auxiliary, (Eleanore Tribe 646-5629)
- 6. Completed application forms must be mailed before (1st of AUGUST of the year commencing studies) to The Royal Canadian Legion Nanton Branch #80 c/o PO Box 299, Nanton or Ladies Auxiliary, Nanton Branch #80 c/o PO Box 299, Nanton.
- 7. When mailing applications, they must be postmarked by August 1.
  When hand delivering or emailing applications, they must be received by August 1, NO LATER.
