We are saddened at the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II Queen of Canada. Flags at Livingstone Range School Division schools and Division Office are lowered to half-mast in respect during the mourning period and through the accession day of the King. Provincial condolence books will be available online and at some provincial buildings throughout the province; a provincial public memorial will be held on the last day of mourning.
